***Refund Policy (Exam Fees Only):** Exam or Re-exam fees are refundable in the amount of \$150 if Applicant withdraws by the 1st day of the month in which the exam is given; other fees are not refundable and no fees are transferable.

**** Re-Activate Bar Application:** Exam Scores are valid for three years but applicants approved for licensing must take the oath of admission, completing the licensing process within 2 years. Applicants with valid scores but an expired investigation shall submit a Re-Activation Application, a supplemental NCBE application and request for background investigation, and pay the fee. Upon receipt of the completed supplemental background investigation and approval of the Board, an amended Certificate of Eligibility will be issued.
