**ORDER**

The Board of Law Examiners has indicated that capacity has been reached in its Knoxville and Memphis testing locations for the July 2022 bar examination in Tennessee, and that capacity has nearly been reached in its Nashville testing location. Accordingly, it is ORDERED as follows.

Upon reaching capacity at the testing location in Nashville, applications for the July 2022 bar examination will close. Any applicant with a submitted and paid application as of the time capacity has been reached will have until May 20, 2022, in which to complete the application process. If there are more applications submitted and paid than there are available seats when the application closes, those without a seat will be placed on a wait-list for Nashville. If a seat is not available by June 15, 2022, those applicants without a seat will be given a refund of the filing fee and withdrawn from the examination.
