## NON-U.S. LAW DEGREE VERIFICATION AND DEAN'S CERTIFICATION: FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS

For a first-time applicant by examination to the Tennessee Bar who received a law degree outside the United States, the "Non-U.S. Law Degree Verification and Dean's Certification" must be submitted directly to the Board of Law Examiners by each non-U.S. law school that applicant attended, whether or not a degree was awarded. Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 7, Sec. 6.06. **The attached forms are required to be completed by the law schools for any First Time or UBE Transfer applicant to the Bar of Tennessee. Pages 2 -4 for all applicants, and page 5, where applicable, must be received on or before December 20 for a February UBE administration or May 20 for a July administration.**<sup>1</sup> Included are the following forms:

I. **Applicant's Authorization and Release** (Page 1): **To be completed by the Applicant**

INSTRUCTIONS: Complete the Authorization and Release Form (page 1) and sign under oath and in the presence of a notary. Complete the information in the box at the top of each form and **forward all pages to your law school(s) with the Authorization and Release form**. An electronic notarial acknowledgement is permitted. If your school permits, you may instead sign this under penalty of perjury and must state that above your signature. The completed forms must be mailed or uploaded directly by your law school to the office of the Tennessee Board of Law Examiners so that the form is received by the deadline for applications. The burden is on the Applicant to ensure timely filing of the Non-U.S. Law Degree Verification and Dean Certification; as such, it is recommended you provide the form to your law school with sufficient time prior to the deadline for the school to complete and send the form. If mailed, use of a mailing service with tracking is recommended.

II. **Non-U.S. Law Degree Verification Form and Certificate of Dean of Law School** (Pages 2 - 5): **To be completed by Law School**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR LAW SCHOOLS: Once complete, this three-page form must be mailed directly to the office of the Tennessee Board of Law Examiners (address above) or uploaded using the secure link provided by the TBLE. Do not send completed forms to the student. Please complete and upload with the form the Authentication found on page 5 and include that with the form upload so that the Board may reach out to you if any questions arise. The form must be **received by December 20 for a February examination and May 20 for a July examination. IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT LAW SCHOOLS USE THE SECURE UPLOAD OPTION FOR THE COMPLETED FORMS.** If grades and graduation information are not available, the school can submit the form with the anticipated graduation date and submit the Late Degree Confirmation Form (Item III) to verify completion of all requirements for graduation. This form is also used if the Applicant attended but did not graduate from a law school.

III. **Late Confirmation of Degree Form** (Page 6): **To be completed by the Law School if not graduated at time of completing pages 2 and 3, above**

This form is retained by the school and used to verify completion of all requirements for graduation if Applicant had not completed requirements for graduation when the Non-U.S. Law Degree Verification form was submitted. The form must be received by the Board of Law Examiners directly from the law school on or before the Friday immediately preceding the dates of the exam or the Applicant will not be eligible to sit for the examination.

**IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING DEADLINE:** Applicants to the Bar of Tennessee are responsible for ensuring that all documents are submitted to the Board of Law Examiners (TBLE) in a timely manner. As such, the Applicant must submit the Non-U.S. Law Degree Verification to the law school with sufficient time for it to be processed by the school and mailed or uploaded to the TBLE office prior to the deadline for applications, which is **December 20 for a February examination and May 20 for a July examination. *The Board of Law Examiners will not consider forms received after the deadline and the Applicant will not be eligible to sit for the examination regardless of delays by law school.*** IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT LAW SCHOOLS USE THE SECURE UPLOAD OPTION FOR THE COMPLETED FORMS.
